



Capacity expansion at the German locations







- ➤ Completion in 2016
- ➤ More than 1,000 m of berth
- ➤ Capacity increase of 1.9 million TEUs to a total of
 - 6.0 million TEUs



EUROKOMBI Terminal GmbH, Hamburg

- With 700,000 cargo units the largest railway station for combined freight transport in Germany
- Directly on the site of the EUROGATE terminal

Area	180,000 m²
Modul 1	6 handling tracks, each 720 m in length 4 cranes capacity 400,000 cargo units
Modul 2	5 handling tracks, each 720 m in length 2 cranes capacity 300,000 cargo units







- Germany's only deep water port directly on the North Sea coast (open sea)
- Common-user terminal
- > Start of operations in 2011
