<i>Area</i>	2,787,000 m ²
<i>Quay length</i>	4,680 m
<i>Number of berths</i>	11 + 4 short sea berths
<i>Water depth</i>	14 m – 16.5 m
<i>Gantries</i>	40
<i>Straddle Carrier</i>	264
<i>Reefer Points</i>	5,419

<i>Straddle Carrier</i>	140
<i>Reach Stacker</i>	1
<i>Reefer Points</i>	900

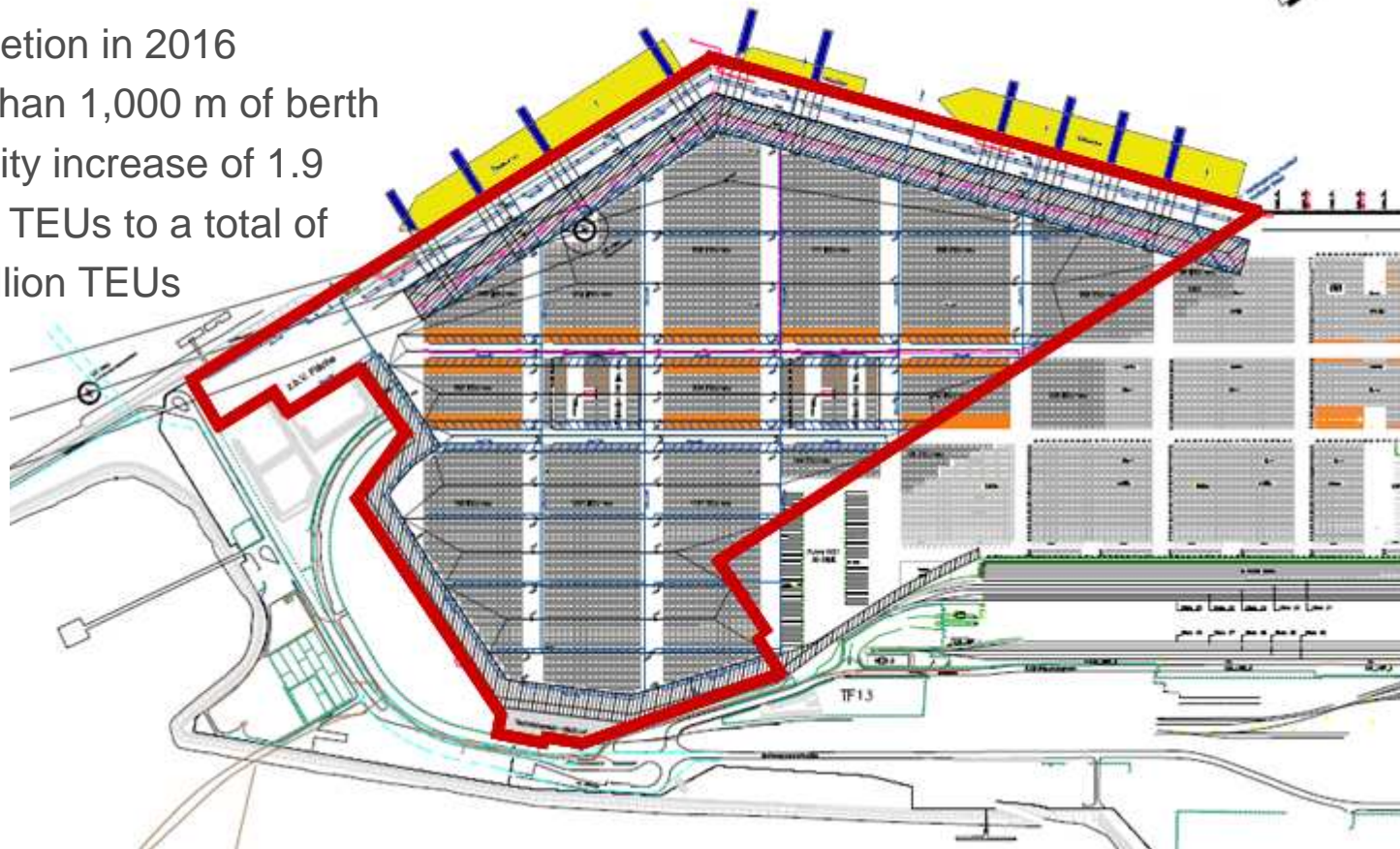


Capacity expansion at the German locations

► 11

New capacities: westward expansion towards Bubenday-Ufer

- Filling in of the Petroleumhafen
- Completion in 2016
- More than 1,000 m of berth
- Capacity increase of 1.9 million TEUs to a total of 6.0 million TEUs



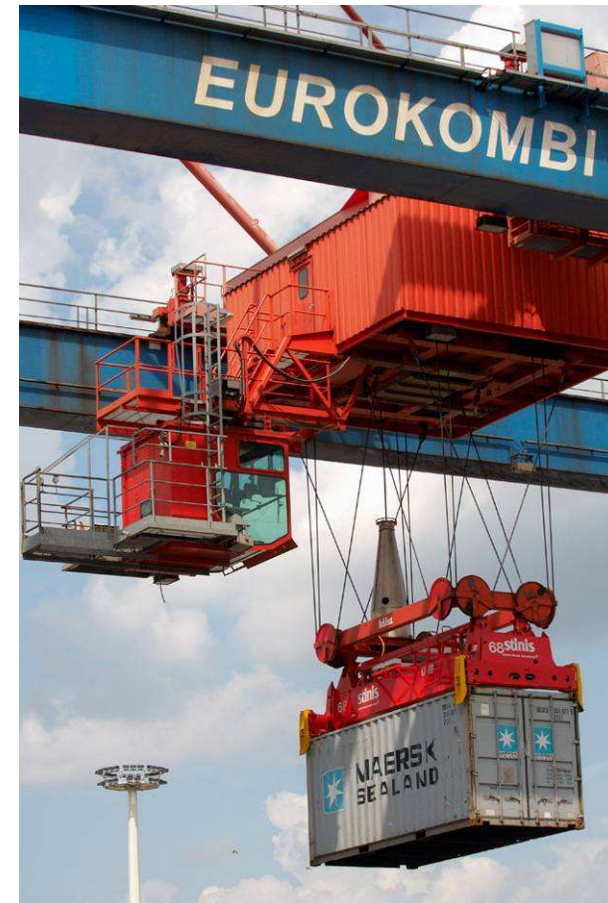
Container Handling in Germany

EUROKOMBI Terminal GmbH, Hamburg

- With 700,000 cargo units the largest railway station for combined freight transport in Germany
- Directly on the site of the EUROGATE terminal

<i>Area</i>	180,000 m ²
<i>Modul 1</i>	6 handling tracks, each 720 m in length 4 cranes capacity 400,000 cargo units
<i>Modul 2</i>	5 handling tracks, each 720 m in length 2 cranes capacity 300,000 cargo units



Container Handling in Germany

EUROGATE Container Terminal Wilhelmshaven

- Germany's only deep water port directly on the North Sea coast (open sea)
- Common-user terminal
- Start of operations in 2011

<i>Area</i>	1.2 Mio. m ²
<i>Quay length</i>	1,725 m
<i>Number of berths</i>	4
<i>Water depth</i>	18 m
<i>Gantries</i>	16
<i>Straddle Carrier</i>	68
<i>Loading cranes</i>	5
<i>Handling capacity</i>	2.7 Mio. TEU p. a.
