





Customs Districts



Finnish Customs controls legal and uncovers illicit flows of goods :

- collects taxes, charges and customs duties
- promotes a smooth flow of legal foreign trade
- protects society



Vaalimaa Customs

- opened at 1958
- busiest border crossing point on the eastern border of Finland
- open 24 hours a day since 1993
- personnel 125



Tasks of Vaalimaa Customs

- Customs clearance centre
- Basic control and surveillance
- Container inspection system
- Prevention of customs crimes
- Investigation of customs crimes
- Joint intelligence centre – customs, border guards and police



Co-operation

- police, customs and frontier guards



- co-operation with Russian authorities
 - based on agreements between states
 - change of information and officers
- co-operation with other authorities
 - forwarding agencies
 - veterinarian
 - Plant Production Inspection Centre

Vaalimaa BCP 2006

- Vehicles about 1,2 million
 - trucks about 440 000
 - personnel cars about 800 000
 - buses about 20 000
- Passengers 2,65 million
 - Fin 18 %
 - Rus 76 %
- Cargo traffic:
import and export
total 3,2 mill. tons



Crimes in Vaalimaa Customs 2006

- Tax frauds
 - smuggling of cigarettes:
 - confiscated 38 000 blocks
(abt. 7,6 mill pcs) of cigarettes
- Smuggling of alcoholic beverages
 - confiscated 3 000 l of alcohol
- Confiscation of heroin in august 2005
- Crimes against immaterial rights
 - trade marks
- Violation of orders given by customs



Lipre

- License Plate Recognition System
- reads and takes a picture of license plates and container numbers
- recognizes nationality
- data base collects information: date, time, speed and a photo of the vehicle

Alarms

- license plate information and a reason for controlling a certain vehicle are put on the system
- an sms-message comes to a phone and on the screen



Container Inspection system

- opened at the beginning of year 2000, update 2006-2007
- supplier of the equipment: French-German Heimann Systems
- cost 11,9 million euro
- four such stations in Europe
- can be used to x-ray trucks, buses, vans, passenger cars
- about 1% of all vehicles crossing the border by Vaalimaa are x-rayed – 3% of all trucks .
- about 12 000 vehicles are x-rayed annually
- as a result there have been confiscated cigarettes, alcohol, drugs and counterfeit goods



Future

- making the road wider between Virojoki-Hamina 2007
- new parking lot for trucks 2008
- separation of personnel and cargo traffic 2009
